Program Responsibilities

The community engagement intern, in collaboration with the director of community engagement, will work closely with Arsht staff and stakeholders to ensure the most effective outcomes for the department and its community events.

The community engagement intern will assist with:

- Educational planning, evaluation and ongoing management of community engagement partners and projects.
- Coordination of community engagement events.
- Coordination, communication and hosting artists that are a part of the community engagements events and meetings.
- On-site logistics of community engagement events.
- Research and data collection for local artists and arts partners.
- Occasional assistance with evening or weekend special events requiring additional staff.
- Conducting research relevant to youth arts enrichment curriculum development, best practices in contemporary youth arts education and as needed.
- Preparing for meetings, surveys and other ways of communicating with and receiving feedback from



artists, arts partners and community members about Arsht community engagement programs.

• Coordinating logistics across multiple departments to advance community engagement program needs.

Program Requirements

- College junior or senior status, pursuing a degree in art education, special education, education leadership, performing arts, social work, arts management, related field or one (1) year experience working in an educational environment or community youth organization.
- Must be at least 18 years old (prior to starting the internship).
- Strong written, verbal and interpersonal communication skills.
- Assist with special projects/assignments as required.
- Must be willing to learn.
- Minimum 15 hours up to 24 hours of availability weekly.
- Strong interest in the arts.
