More than 150 high school musicians learn from the artists in-person before each concert and attend the performance for free

Miami, FL – July 26, 2023 – The Adrienne Arsht Center for the Performing Arts of Miami-Dade County (@arshtcenter) is proud to present the 2023-2024 season of **JAZZ ROOTS**, which returns to the Center's Knight Concert Hall with four curated evenings of live music that celebrate American and Latin jazz masters.

The 2023-2024 season of **JAZZ ROOTS** features four unforgettable evenings of jazz, featuring top headliners, exciting new artists and once-in-a-lifetime musical moments. The season kicks off on November 3, 2023 with a celebration of the legacy of composer **Henry Mancini**, featuring the composer's daughter Monica Mancini, the Frost School of Music's Henry Mancini Institute Orchestra and other special guests to be announced soon. Celebrate the season on December 1, 2023 with holiday favorites by saxophonist **Dave Koz** and special guests. **JAZZ ROOTS** continues into 2024 with the reunion of **Chucho Valdés and Irakere**, 50 years after they changed the face of Latin music, on February 9, 2024; and wraps up with the smooth baritone vocals of **Gregory Porter** on February 23, 2024.

"The longstanding tradition of **JAZZ ROOTS** presenting the genre's brightest stars continues with the thrilling lineup for the upcoming 2023-2024 season, which was specially curated for Miami audiences and showcases the best of jazz today," said Liz Wallace, vice president of programming for the Arsht Center.

JAZZ ROOTS 2023-2024 series subscriptions, which include tickets to all four performances, are on sale to the public beginning July 26 with seating priority given to renewing subscribers. Four-concert subscription packages range in price from \$158-\$414* and can be purchased online at arshtcenter.org/jazz or by calling the Arsht Center Box Office at 305-949-6722. Single tickets will go on sale on September 8.

THE HENRY MANCINI 100TH BIRTHDAY CELEBRATION

Friday, November 3, 2023 at 8 p.m.

From "Moon River" (Breakfast at Tiffany's) and "Love Theme from Romeo and Juliet" to the timelessly iconic Pink Panther theme, **HENRY MANCINI** (@henrymancini) composed



some of the most beloved music of our time while revolutionizing the art of film scoring. The Frost School of Music's **Henry Mancini Institute Orchestra** (@hmifrostschool) will join Henry's daughter, two-time Grammy-nominated vocalist **Monica Mancini** and eight-time Grammy winner **Gregg Field**, plus other surprise guest artists in a multi-media spectacular to celebrate Mancini's 100th birthday.

DAVE KOZ & FRIENDS CHRISTMAS TOUR 2023

Friday, December 1, 2023 at 8 p.m.

DAVE KOZ AND FRIENDS announce the 26th anniversary of the longest-running jazz-based Christmas tour. Beginning the next era of this rich musical tradition, Koz and Friends will perform fresh renditions of timeless Christmas classics – as well as a Hanukkah medley – and hits from their respective catalogs. The tour reunites Koz with a longtime musical partner, guitarist/singer **Jonathan Butler** and will feature special guests, saxophonist/flutist **Marcus Anderson** making his debut, and vocalist **Rebecca Jade**, marking her third time with the tour. Traversing 25 cities in one month, the tour will also introduce musical prodigy **Justin Lee Schultz**, a 16-year-old South Africa-born, U.S. based pianist, guitarist, vocalist and social media sensation.

CHUCHO VALDÉS: IRAKERE 50

Friday, February 9, 2024 at 8 p.m.

Fresh off the world premiere of his epic work *La Creación* at the Arsht Center in 2021, Cuban pianist and composer **CHUCHO VALDÉS** (@chuchovaldesmusic) reunites with former bandmates to commemorate 50 years of **IRAKERE**, the legendary Afro-Cuban jazz band he founded which changed the face of Latin music forever. ARTISTRY & SOUL: AN EVENING WITH GREGORY PORTER Friday, February 23, 2024 at 8 p.m.

An artist whose music is at once timeless yet utterly of its time, **GREGORY PORTER** (@gregoryportermusic) has solidified his standing as his generation's most soulful jazz singer-songwriter with two Best Jazz Vocal Album GRAMMY Awards – one for 2017's Take Me to the Alley and the other in 2014 for his Blue Note debut Liquid Spirit. Liquid Spirit followed the critically acclaimed and GRAMMY-nominated albums Water (2010) and Be Good (2012) selling one million albums worldwide and becoming the most streamed jazz album of all time with more than 20 million streams. Porter has more than 1.3 billion career streams. In 2017, Porter released the heartfelt tribute album, Nat King Cole & Me, and, in 2020, returned to his original songwriting on the uplifting All Rise. For more information, visit gregoryporter.com.

<u>CHRIS BOTTI</u> Friday, February 16, 2024 at 8 p.m.

For over two decades, Grammy Award-winning master trumpeter and composer **CHRIS BOTTI** (@chrisbottimusic) has amassed a spectacular variety of honors, including multiple Gold and Platinum albums, to become the nation's best-selling instrumental artist. His mesmerizing performances with a stunning array of legends such as Sting, Barbra Streisand, Tony Bennett, Yo-Yo Ma, Frank Sinatra, Paul Simon and Andrea Bocelli, have cemented his place as one of the most brilliant and inspiring forces of the contemporary music scene. Whether he's performing with illustrious symphonies or at renowned venues around the globe, his unparalleled crystalline and poetic sound transcends musical boundaries. MAVIS STAPLES

Friday, March 8, 2024 at 8 p.m.

A true icon of soul music, **MAVIS STAPLES** (@mavisstaples) has captivated audiences for over six decades with her powerful and soul-stirring voice. As a member of the renowned Staple Singers, she played a pivotal role in shaping the sound of gospel, soul, and R&B. Hailed by NPR as "one of America's defining voices of freedom and peace," she is the kind of once-in-a-generation artist whose impact on music and culture would be difficult to overstate. From her early involvement in the civil rights movement to her timeless collaborations with contemporary artists, she has effortlessly bridged generational gaps and musical genres. Staples is both a Blues and Rock and Roll Hall of Fame inductee and an 11-time Grammy Award winner. She has been honored with a Grammy Lifetime Achievement Award and is a National Arts Awards Lifetime Achievement recipient and Kennedy Center honoree. ABOUT JAZZ ROOTS

The Arsht Center's **JAZZ ROOTS** series is an institution in Miami music and has been enjoyed by more than 88,000 people. In addition, the series has benefitted more than 15,000 high school jazz music students who have participated in the accompanying **JAZZ ROOTS**: **SoundCheck** educational program. **JAZZ ROOTS** was co-created by the Adrienne Arsht Center in 2008 with the late music industry entrepreneur Larry Rosen and, since then, has presented a rich variety of thematic concerts exploring the spectrum of jazz and featuring more than 160 of the greatest living jazz artists/ensembles on the scene today. Since its inception, the series has included jazz superstars such as Jon Batiste, George Benson, Dee Dee Bridgewater, Dave Brubeck, Chick Corea, Paquito D'Rivera, Michael Feinstein, Keith Jarrett, Eddie Palmieri, Sonny Rollins and Chucho Valdés as well as worldclass ensembles, including the Jazz at Lincoln Center Orchestra with Wynton Marsalis, the Count Basie Orchestra and the New Orleans Jazz Orchestra. Quincy Jones has heralded **JAZZ ROOTS** as "the most important new jazz and educational series in America!" This history-making series has sold out dozens of concerts.



Arts Education Program

JAZZ ROOTS also features **JAZZ ROOTS: SoundCheck**, an in-depth educational partnership with Miami-Dade County Public Schools which has brought more than 15,000 high school music students to the Center for a complimentary and unique behind-the-scenes experience including: access to the pre-concert sound check; a Q&A session with featured artists followed by a workshop with a local jazz expert that will highlight the music, the artistic process and the practical skills needed for a career in the arts; and free entry to the evening's performance, with transportation and dinner provided free of charge.
