On his international Agradecido Tour, José Luis Rodríguez, better known as El Puma, performs an array of ballads and pop songs that have brought joy to many people throughout the singer's 55-year career. Rodriguez's all-time hits include "Atrévete," "Me Vas a Echar de Menos" and "Pavo Real." He wrote his most recent album, 2019's Agradecido, with Erika Ender, a Grammy Award-winning writer of reggaeton hit "Despacito."

Leann RIMES - JOY: THE HOLIDAY TOUR

LeAnn Rimes, the pop singer who first hit the charts at 13 years old (with the country song "Blue"), performs a Christmas concert filled with holiday standards and original music.



Rimes is a multiplatinum-selling singer and ASCAP Award-winning songwriter. She has sold more than 48 million units, won two Grammy Awards, 12 Billboard Music Awards, two World Music Awards, three Academy of Country Music Awards, two Country Music Association Awards and one Dove Award. At 14, Rimes became the youngest solo artist to win the Grammy Award for best new artist. At 15, she became the first country artist to win artist of the year at the Billboard Music Awards.

The past couple of years have been quite a resurgence for Rimes. In 2022, the worldrenowned singer had a big year that included the release of her 19th album, God's Work. The album, which features artists such as Ziggy Marley, Mickey Guyton, Aloe Blacc and Ben Harper, was No. 9 on Variety's list of the best albums of 2022. "You won't find a richer collection of melodic writing on any album released this year, with the twists and turns that maybe only someone capable of all that virtuosic vocalizing could think to take a set of songs into," the magazine raved. In April 2022, Rimes headlined an episode of the music series CMT Crossroads titled "LeAnn Rimes & Friends" alongside Mickey Guyton, Carly Pearce, Ashley McBryde and Brandy Clark, who helped commemorate Rimes' career and recognize the path she blazed for women in all genres.

For over two decades, Grammy Award-winning master trumpeter and composer Chris Botti has amassed a spectacular variety of honors, including multiple Gold and Platinum albums, to become the nation's largest selling instrumental artist. His mesmerizing performances with a stunning array of legends such as Sting, Barbra Streisand, Tony Bennett, Yo-Yo Ma, Frank Sinatra, Paul Simon and Andrea Bocelli have cemented his place as one of the most brilliant and inspiring forces of the contemporary music scene. Whether he's performing with illustrious symphonies or at renowned venues around the globe, his unparalleled crystalline and poetic sound transcends musical boundaries.

JULIETA VENEGAS

Julieta Venegas is one of the greatest Latin pop music artists. A Mexican musician, composer and singer, she has established herself as an international star. Her great versatility and talent have led her to perform in the biggest stages and festivals worldwide, obtaining the recognition of Gold and Platinum records in countries such as Mexico, USA, Italy, Argentina, Brazil and Spain.

Throughout her vast career, Venegas has been recognized with 2 Grammy Awards, 11 Latin Grammy Awards, 2 Billboard Music Awards and 7 MTV Awards, among thirty other awards. Her greatest hits "Lento," "Limón y Sal," "Me Voy," "Andar Conmigo," have become anthems for an entire generation and are still relevant today among young audiences who discover in her voice an authentic and relatable message to identify with.

With more than 14 million monthly listeners on Spotify, Venegas has collaborated with artists such as Tainy, Bad Bunny, Sen Senra, Dom La Nena, No Te Va a Gustar, among others. Her collaboration with Tainy and Bad Bunny won the Latin Grammy for Best Reggaeton Performance and the track has more than 626 million plays.

MAVIS STAPLES

A true icon of soul music, Mavis Staples has captivated audiences for over six decades with her powerful and soul-stirring voice. As a member of the renowned Staple Singers, she played a pivotal role in shaping the sound of gospel, soul, and R&B. Hailed by NPR as "one of America's defining voices of freedom and peace," she is the kind of once-in-ageneration artist whose impact on music and culture would be difficult to overstate. From her early involvement in the civil rights movement to her timeless collaborations with contemporary artists, she has effortlessly bridged generational gaps and musical genres. Staples is both a Blues and Rock and Roll Hall of Fame inductee and an 11-time Grammy Award winner. She has been honored with a Grammy Lifetime Achievement Award and is a National Arts Awards Lifetime Achievement recipient and Kennedy Center honoree. Set in the heart of downtown Miami, the Adrienne Arsht Center for the Performing Arts of Miami-Dade County is committed to welcoming and connecting ALL people to the arts, to the Arsht Center and to each other. Our stages are alive year-round with artists from around the world, innovative programming from our resident companies and local arts partners, free community events that reflect Miami's unique identity and arts education experiences for thousands of Miami children each year.



Since opening in 2006, the Arsht Center, a 501C3 non-profit organization, has been recognized as a catalyst for billions of dollars in new development in the downtown area, a leader in programming that mirrors South Florida's diversity, a host venue for historic events and Miami's hub for arts education.

Each year, we serve more than 60,000 young learners and offer more than 100 culturally diverse and inclusive education programs — many enhanced by the Arsht Center's relationship with Miami-Dade County Public Schools, local teaching artists and Miami-based arts organizations.

The Arsht Center is also a home stage for three resident companies — Florida Grand Opera, Miami City Ballet and New World Symphony — and a launch pad for local artists to make their mark on the international stage. Our 300+ events each year include the Center's Signature Series of classical, jazz, Broadway, local theater and much more. We present a robust series of touring Broadway musicals direct from New York, the largest jazz series in South Florida, a major annual Flamenco Festival and an award-winning Miami-based theater program.
