Program Responsibilities

The Adrienne Arsht Center Development department is seeking a motivated and talented fundraising Intern to join the team. This internship program is designed to provide valuable real-world experience to individuals who would like to learn more about fundraising in nonprofit organizations. As a Development Intern, you will work closely with the development team, and gain hands-on experience in planning, implementing and evaluating fundraising projects.

The Development Intern will assist with:

- Collaborating with the development team in organizing and executing fundraising events, campaigns and donor stewardship activities.
- Contributing to the creation of compelling content for fundraising materials, including brochures, impact reports, grants, emails, newsletters and social media posts.
- Conducting research to identify potential donors, funding opportunities, grants and partnerships relevant to our organization's goals.
- Help maintain accurate records and documentation related to development activities, including donor databases, grant files and project reports.
- Participation in meetings and discussions with the development team, providing input and sharing ideas to improve fundraising strategies and initiatives.

Program Requirements

- College Junior or Senior status, pursuing a degree in nonprofit management, business administration or a related discipline.
(Preferred, not required)
- Must be at least 18 years old (prior to starting the internship).

- Strong organizational skills with the ability to manage multiple tasks and prioritize effectively.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills.
- Proficient in Microsoft Office suite (Word, Excel, PowerPoint).
- A keen attention to detail and accuracy for data entry and documentation.
- Ability to work independently as well as collaboratively in a team-oriented environment.
- Demonstrated passion for social causes, philanthropy and nonprofit organizations.
- Occasional assistance with evening or weekend special events requiring additional staff.
- Minimum 20 hours up to 24 hours of availability weekly.
- Strong interest in the arts.
